Special Section Proposal Form

The Journal of Great Lakes Research (JGLR) welcomes groups of authors to submit manuscripts targeting a selected topic, which would together make up a "Special Section." Special sections are usually published as part of any one of the six issues published each year. Occasionally, if the group of papers is large (>40 articles) or will have a sponsor covering open access costs, the special section may comprise the entire issue. An issue containing a special section will feature the special section on the cover, with the list of Guest Editors, a photo, and the special section title. Special sections are placed at the front of the regular issue in which they are part, and include an Introductory Article written by the Guest Editor team. Special sections are also featured as JGLR Article Collections on the Elsevier Science Direct website and articles are available online soon after they are accepted, not requiring the whole special section to be ready before being accessible.

Costs:

There are no page charges for any articles submitted to JGLR regardless of whether they are regular articles or articles for a special section. While there is no cost for authors to publish colour figures in the online version there is a \$400 US fee for each colour figure authors wish to have in the printed version of the article. If authors wish to have open access there is a fee of \$2,500 if any of the authors are IAGLR members and \$2,750 if none of the authors are IAGLR members (based on fees in 2021).

Opportunities exist for organizations to sponsor Open Access of an entire special section, which may allow for reduced Open Access costs, but these must be negotiated with Elsevier on a case-by-case basis. Sponsorship requires specific discussions at the beginning of the section development process, so please include any interest in section sponsorship in the Special Section Description on page 2.
