1. Call to Order

President Keri Hornbuckle called the meeting to order at 1220h, and explained the meeting's format to the membership. With no objections made, the meeting continued.

2. Approval of the Agenda

A motion to approve the meeting agenda (Attachment A) was offered by Deborah Swackhamer, seconded by Ron Hites, and was unanimously supported.

3. Approval of the Minutes of the 2004 Annual Business Meeting

A motion to approve the minutes of the 2004 Annual Business Meeting (copies of which were available for viewing at each table) was offered by Dennis Hansen, seconded by Mellissa Halting, and was unanimously supported.

4. Treasurer's Report

Treasurer Bill Booty presented a financial statement and summary of the association's standing for the year ending 31 December 2004 (Attachment B). He noted that the audit for 2004, by James R. Stuchell and Associates, is in progress. In summary, total revenue during 2004 was \$455,015.24, whereas total expenses were \$343,800.49. This resulted in a net operating balance for IAGLR in 2004 of \$111,214.75, which the Treasurer cautioned was due in part to major disbursements for the 2004 Conference being paid out in 2005.

The endowment and scholarship funds (AMEX Calvert Mutal Funds) continued to inch upward in value through 2004. A breakdown of the values of the Calvert Funds is charted for Jan 2004 to Feb 2005. No monies were withdrawn from the funds for scholarships in 2004 in order to promote growth. Scholarships were paid from general operating funds.

The 2004 conference at the University of Waterloo was a great success with a net surplus of \$35,264.80 being generated for IAGLR.

5. President's Report

President Hornbuckle's report focused on IAGLR's new 5-Year Plan (Attachment C). She began by announcing the decision by the Board of Directors to drop page charges for regular issues (excluding color pages) of the Journal of Great Lakes Research, effective immediately. She then delivered the following power point presentation that outlined the Plan to the membership:

- (2) Increase the fee for a Sustaining Membership from \$1000 to \$1500 per year, and
- (3) Discontinue the Contributing Membership category

was moved by Ralph Smith, seconded by Deborah Swackhamer, and passed unanimously.

A motion to amend <u>Article VIII (Auditing)</u> to:

 Change the fiscal year from 1 January through 31 December to 1 October through 30 September

was moved by Lisa Tulen, seconded by Bob Heath, and passed unanimously.

8. Motion of Responsibility

The Motion of Responsibility was offered by Ralph Smith: "Resolved, that all acts, contracts, proceedings, and payments of money made by the Officers and Directors of the Association in their conduct of affairs of the Association since the last Annual General Meeting held May 26, 2003, be approved. The same are hereby ratified, confirmed, and sanctioned." The motion was seconded by Deborah Swackhamer, and unanimously approved by the membership.

9. Recognition of Outgoing Board Members:

President Hornbuckle noted that the terms of Ralph Smith as Past President, Hunter Carrick as Board Member, Tom Johengen as Board Member, Jeremy VanDerWal as Student Board Member, and Lee Grapentine as Secretary had expired and expressed thanks to them for their service and contribution to the Association.

10. Announcement of New Board Members:

President Hornbuckle then introduced the newly elected Board members: Lynda Corkum and Charles Ramcharan (Regular Members), Lisa Tulen (Student Member), and Chris Marvin (Secretary). As the next Past President, she looked forward to working with them during the next year and thanked the Association and Board for allowing her to serve as President.

11. Transfer of the Chair:

President Hornbuckle introduced the 2005-2006 President of the Association, Tim Johnson, and transferred the authority of the chair. President Johnson thanked President Hornbuckle for all of her work in the past year, including spearheading development of the new 5-Year Plan. He pledged to continue her good efforts and invited all members to attend next year's IAGLR conference in Windsor, Ontario.

12. Adjournment:

President Johnson adjourned the meeting at 1300h.

Treasurer's report May 24, 2005

Financial Summary

This report gives a preliminary summary of the association's financial standing for the year ending December 31, 2004. The audit for 2004 is currently being carried out by James R. Stuchell & Associates.

Total revenue during 2004 was \$455,015.24 while there were total expenses of \$343,800.49. This resulted in a net operating balance for IAGLR for 2004 of \$111,214.75. This unexpectedly large surplus for 2004 is due to major disbursements for the 2004 conference being paid out in 2005, increased income from journal page charges (supplemental issues) and from institutional dues, and the MNR student travel award funding.

The endowment and scholarship funds continue to move mostly up with the market as shown in the attached chart. In order to help let the funds grow in 2004, scholarships were paid from general operating funds.

The 2004 conference at the University of Waterloo was a great success with a net surplus of \$35,264.80 being generated for IAGLR.

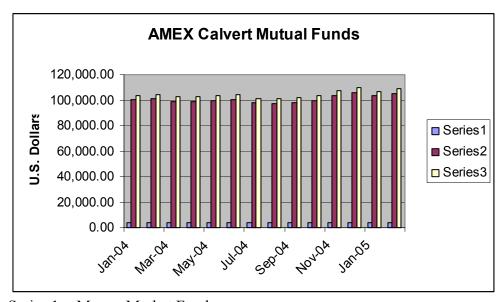
