


- 1. To log into the Meeting App, visit the "Sign In" link in the navigation menu.

If you have created a password for this meeting, you will be prompted to enter it.




If you haven't created a password for this meeting, you will be asked to create one.



JOIN VIRTUAL EVENTS

From the navigation menu, use the "Meeting Calendar" or "Program" options to explore. The Meeting Calendar allows you to browse happenings each day, while the Program option lets you explore by event type.



To access the Zoom Meeting and Webinar links, visit a session of interest. You'll see "Join Virtual Event" text under each, as shown highlighted at left. When the event goes live, use the "Join Now" links that will become active 20 minutes before the start of the session and look similar to this:
